# Children's Developmental Services Support Workers - Casual

The **CDS Support Worker** works in a supportive role with children and youth with disabilities, and their families. Activities may include: In-home personal support care; short term respite for family caregivers; supporting youth involvement in community outings (social, recreational or skill-enhancing).
