



Bursary for Driver's Education Program

This Children's Aid Foundation Bursary has been developed to assist youth with Crown Ward status and young adults who previously had Crown Ward status with The Children's Aid Society of the District of Thunder Bay, to achieve independence skills and career goals.

The bursary is offered to young people who wish to obtain a driver's license and complete a Driver's Education Program.

This bursary will provide **up to** seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) towards the cost of a Driver's Education Program.

Eligibility:

This bursary is available to:

- Persons who have Crown Ward status , or who had Crown Ward status with the Children's Aid Society of the District of Thunder Bay on their 18th birthday and are currently on an Extended Care and Maintenance Agreement , and
- Are now 16 years of age or older.

What to Include in the Application:

Information that the applicant and references provide will be considered in awarding the bursaries. This information consists of:

- **Application Form**

Please complete the attached Application Form.

- **Reference**

Include a write up by the applicant's CAS worker or former worker, or another suitable adult reference, stating why they feel the young adult should be awarded this bursary. The reference must demonstrate that the young person is achieving to the best of their ability.
