

### CHILDREN'S DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES SUPPORT WORKERS

This position presents an excellent opportunity for individuals beginning their careers in the Human Services or Developmental Services field, or for those possessing a special interest in, and experience working with others in a helping role. This position is casual in nature, varying from 5 to 20 hours per week dependent on individual family needs. The **CDS Support Worker** works in a supportive role with children and youth with disabilities, and their families. Activities may include: In-home personal support care; short term respite for family caregivers; and supporting youth involvement in community outings (social, recreational or skill-enhancing). Those offered employment will be required to provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination or written medical exemption.

Mileage reimbursement of \$.49 cents per kilometer

- Graduate of, or enrollment in Human Services post-secondary program and/or experience working with children and youth with disabilities and their caregivers
- Ability to appreciate people's differences and unique strengths

- Highly organized and reliable
- Demonstrated ability to develop helping, supportive relationships with others

- Upon conditional offer of employment:
  - Current Criminal Records Check Vulnerable Sector and consent to a Child Welfare Check; results deemed satisfactory by the Agency.
  - Confirmation applicant possesses a valid "G" Driver's License and safe driving record (as defined by no more than two driving offences in the past three-year period, and/or no more than five demerit points)
